Cr Nelson commented that Council was pleased to be able to offer such a diverse range of events and activities. “The school holiday program is scheduled after extensive consultation with young people and their families during school terms. We are very pleased with the ongoing growth in numbers participating and the input from the community regarding this program.” Cr Nelson concluded that Council was very much looking forward to putting these events and activities on for the Hindmarsh Shire community.
