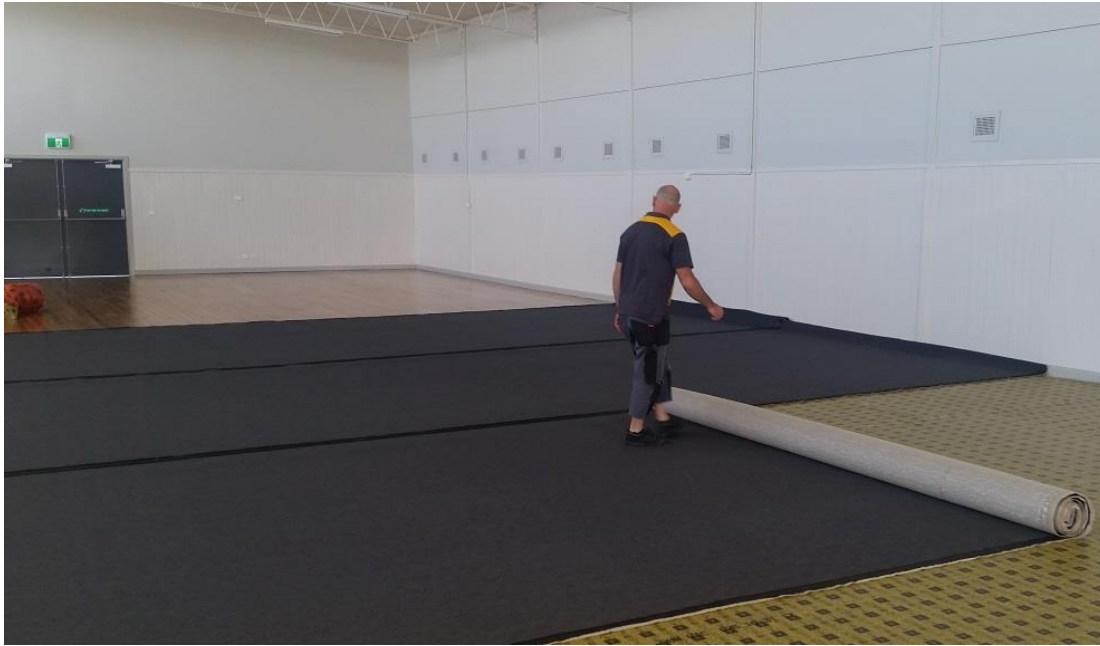
Scheduled for 10am, the opening will give the local community its first opportunity to tour the inside of the facility.
