FIRE RESTRICTION DATES

Country Fire Authority (CFA) declares the Fire Danger Period for each municipality at different times in the lead up to the fire season. The timing can depend on the amount of rain, grassland curing rate and other local conditions.

The Fire Danger Period may be declared as early as October in some municipalities, and typically remains in place until the fire danger lessens, which could be as late as May.

The Fire Danger Period is NOT the same thing as a Total Fire Ban.

JEPARIT ROY STREET REVITALISATION

Materials to replace existing rotten and damaged timber garden beds in the footpaths of Roy Street, Jeparit between Charles Street and Scott Street / Broadway Street, are currently on order. Installation of the new garden bed edging is expected to be undertaken in late 2024 and early 2025, depending on the arrival of materials and the availability of the crew to undertake the work.

The new garden edges will be constructed from a composite material using recycled and reclaimed material that will not rot and requires minimal maintenance. Using this product will divert over 4,500kg of waste material from landfill.

Progression of this initiative follows community drop-in sessions held in Jeparit during August 2024.

Funding for this project has been made available from the Victorian Governments Tiny Towns Program, Hindmarsh Shire Council and the Jeparit Township Advisory Committee.

OUT AND ABOUT IN HINDMARSH



Netherby Baker Road

Works have commenced on a sealed reconstruction approximately 1,100m long which will repair significant damage to pavement. This involves installing new pavement and slag lime stabilisation, and new seal. Works should be wrapped up in early November subject to weather conditions.

Albacutya Road

A major patch has commenced at the bend near the Albacutya Silo Art. Works include improving drainage, installing new pavement and slag lime stabilisation, and new seal. This will repair pavement failure caused by saturated conditions in previous wet seasons.

Keams Road

A resheet has been completed on this road recently, which included installation of new gravel and reforming the shape of the road. This was necessary as the old road had minimal gravel remaining.

Slashing program

Our contractor has recently undertaken our slashing program for 2024/2025. This included cutting roadside weeds and grass to improve visibility and assist with fire breaks for the upcoming fire season. The roads completed included some strategic local roads as well as VicRoads roads under our maintenance contract.
