

Hello councillors & CEO of the Hindmarsh Shire Council,

I wish to bring your attention to correspondence that was sent to the previous cohort of councillors at the end of their service time, and as such you may not be aware of this important issue.

On 11th October 2024, Port Hedland council voted on a motion to ask for the immediate suspension of Moderna and Pfizer modRNA Covid vaccine. This request was sent to all councillors in Australia and the Australian Prime Minister, Mr Anthony Albanese.

Since that meeting 2 other councils in Australia, District Council of Ceduna and West Tamar Council have also moved motions to support the Honourable Russell Broadbent MP in calling for the suspension of the Pfizer and Moderna Covid shots and demanding answers from the Prime Minister.

The study that is backing up Mr Broadbent's request found that vials of Covid vaccines were tested by the industry standard methods and the results have revealed that there is DNA contamination in the vaccines – of up to 145 times above the legal limit.

Although the TGA has released a media statement that this claim is false, there is evidence that the TGA's statement is misleading, as the standard testing on these vaccines was not done by the TGA.

On a personal note, I am sure that you know of family and friends who are experiencing poor health outcomes since the rollout of the vaccine. These concerns are wide ranging and, in some cases, have proved lethal.

As a local council you have a duty of care for the health & safety of the community, and I urge you to consider this important health matter and exercise due diligence when presented with this information.

I would appreciate a response from all councillors & council staff that you have received this email and that you will carefully consider the information in this email.

Re: Email re COVID-19 Vaccinations

Thank you for your email received 23 November 2024 regarding Port Hedland's motion on 11 October 2024. We have carefully reviewed the information you provided, alongside information published by the TGA as detailed below.

Councillors have received your correspondence directly, and they have also been provided with the media release from the Therapeutic Goods Administration entitled 'Addressing misinformation about excessive DNA in the mRNA vaccines' published on 18 October 2024. <u>Information</u> is also available from the TGA on the quality assessment and approval of vaccines supplied in Australia (both overall approval regulation and batch release assessment).

Currently, there is no mandate regarding the administration of the COVID-19 vaccination and people may choose to access these vaccines in consultation with a medical professional.

Councils rely on the expertise, advice and direction from the State and Federal Government regarding pandemic events. We understand that as with all vaccines, the World Health Organisation and regulatory authorities will continuously monitor the use of COVID-19 vaccines to confirm that they remain safe for all who receive them.
