FARMER CONSULTATIONS

Following on from the June consultation sessions, our team will be hosting follow-up sessions in August. During the June sessions, we heard from 54 farmers on which roads were strategic and required Council action, and which roads have tree issues that are causing issues moving machinery from farm to farm.

PROJECT UPDATES

RAINBOW LLEW SCHILLING SILO

Progress with the soon-to-be newest destination on the Mallee Silo Art Trail continues, with the Rainbow project recently obtaining its building permit and planning permit amendment approval.

On the construction side, the Builder is currently working with the manufacturer who will be responsible for making the prefabricated steel structure, which is scheduled for delivery to the site later in the year. It is hoped the tower will be erected before Christmas, with construction to finish in early March.

RAINBOW RISES EVENTS CENTRE

The next few months will be very busy for the Rainbow Rises site, with numerous construction projects to commence shortly. Council has recently executed contracts to deliver a new Amenities Building, a new septic system and a large storage shed and shelter to support the staging of events at the site. The Rainbow Rises site regularly hosts offroad motor racing events and has recently expanded its capacity to also host tractor pull events.

DIMBOOLA SOUNDSHELL

The redevelopment of the Dimboola Soundshell is progressing well. The concrete slab for the new stage area was poured and works on the new concrete apron at the front of the stage, as well as the new allabilities ramp, walkway and car park taking shape. Works are anticipated to be completed by early October 2024.



DAVIS PARK AFL COMPLIANT CHANGEROOMS AND UNDERCOVER SEATING

Sports participants and fans visiting Nhill will hopefully soon enjoy new facilities at the Davis Park Sports Reserve, with a new Grandstand and Change Room set to be constructed ahead of the 2025 Football/Netball season. The Tender for construction closed in early July with plans to appoint a builder to start construction shortly after the conclusion of the 2024 season. The development will incorporate a tiered seating area for approximately 140 spectators, a timekeeper box and a commentary area above new football change rooms.

ROADS & WORKS UPDATE

ALBERT STREET RAINBOW KERB & CHANNEL

Works on the kerb and channel and shoulder sealing were completed in July. This upgrades the previously unsealed shoulder and earth drain between King St and Butter Factory Lane.

TARRANYURK EAST RD RE-SHEET

Works on Tarranyurk East Rd have continued, with another section recently re-sheeted. Further resheeting works on this road will be conducted with this financial year's budget over the coming months. The site will be monitored for gravel performance, aiming to find the best value solution for the site.

VICROADS CONTRACT

Two large patch sections of Dimboola Rainbow Rd, just south of Antwerp were sealed in July. This will complete the works, which repaired two failed sections in accordance with provisional works as part of the VicRoads maintenance contract.

TINY TOWNS FUNDING

Council has been successful with two funding applications through the Victorian Government's first round of Tiny Towns funding.

NHILL OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

Development of a new Off-Leash Dog Park in Nhill will commence soon. The new park, estimated to be approximately 1000m², will be located in the Nhill Lawn Tennis Club precinct on Whitehead Avenue, Nhill. It will feature a water station, dog bag dispenser, rubbish bins, and bench seating for owners and will be fully enclosed with a 1.5m high chain mesh fence and access will be via a double gated system. This will reduce the risk of dogs within the park exiting while others are entering.

This project has also been made possible with funding from Hindmarsh Shire Council and the Nhill Town Committee.

JEPARIT STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS

Roy Street in Jeparit is set to receive streetscape improvements. This includes replacing the existing timber garden bed surrounds with new attractive, maintenance-free composite materials along Roy Street between Charles Street and Scott Street, as well as enhancing the aesthetics of Roy Street whilst improving safety for local and visiting pedestrians using the footpaths.

This project has also been made possible with funding from Hindmarsh Shire Council and the Jeparit Town Committee.

2024 LOCAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

The local council elections will be held in October 2024 via postal vote.

This is your opportunity to both have your say on Councillor representatives from each ward (North, West, and East Wards), but also to consider whether you'd like to make a difference in your community by nominating yourself to run for Council.

The election process is managed by the Victorian Electoral Commission, but Hindmarsh Shire Council has published a guide that provides you with information on running for Council and what the role of a Councillor looks like in our community.

PRE-PREP 2025

Hindmarsh Shire Early Years Services are set to expand ahead of the rollout of Pre-Prep from 2025, with new modular Kinder rooms recently installed onsite in both Dimboola and Nhill.

The new buildings will support increased demand for services with 4YO Kinder transitioning next year to up to 30 hours per week. Once the buildings and landscaping are complete, Council will, in conjunction with its service provider, Emerge Early Years Services, complete the furnishing of each Kinder.
